DONALD SULTAN (b. 1951) earned his BFA from the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill, and his MFA from the School of the Art Institute in Chicago before establishing himself in New York in 1975. Since his solo debut in 1977, Sultan has distinguished himself as a painter, printmaker, and sculptor, renowned for seamlessly merging traditional and modern elements. Sultan's large-scale paintings, which include industrial disasters and still lifes, are bold compositions that employ industrial materials such as tar and concrete, which contribute to their unique texture and character. He describes his works as a blend of basic geometric and organic forms with a constituent purity; they have left an indelible mark on contemporary art. His subjects evolve organically, making powerful statements amid abstraction. Sultan's works, showcased in solo and group exhibitions worldwide, are featured in prestigious permanent collections, including:

FROM PAINTING TO PRINT: The Poppies, Mimosas, and Lantern Flowers of Donald Sultan

Exhibition at American University Museum at the Katzen Arts Center

September 6 - December 7, 2025 in Washington, DC



DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

This exhibition is about prints and relationships. Lococo Fine Art Publisher is a publisher of fine art prints in limited editions based in St. Louis. Missouri, and we work with artists and printers to make prints. Usually, we are the ones coming up with the ideas for the prints and we pay the artists and printers to get them made. After the prints are signed and numbered, we sell and distribute to dealers, galleries, museums, and collectors all over the world. The artists we work with are well-established and most are based in New York City.

This exhibition came about because of our 25+ year relationship with the artist Donald Sultan, our past exhibition here at American University Museum, and my admiration for the prints printed and published by Ken Tyler, founder of Gemini G.E.L. and Tyler Graphics, esteemed print publishers.

Not all print publishers make their own prints and those who do often specialize because of costs and equipment needs. You try to do what you can "in-house" and develop relationships with others who have the skills and expertise to help you get done what's needed. Publishers support an artworld ecosystem made up of paper makers, printers, art dealers, advisers and consultants, interior designers, auction houses, artists, and collectors.

Several years ago I bought an attractive print at auction by Donald Sultan, Four Red Flowers, May 17, 1999 a medium-sized, woodcut printed and published by Tyler Graphics. Ken Tyler revolutionized printmaking to create some of the largest, most technically complex prints ever made. Ken liked to say that the best artists make the best prints, and he allowed them to do whatever they wanted to do in his printshop: lithography, woodcut, etching, silkscreen...the bigger and more challenging the better. Four Red Flowers, May 17, 1999 is a beautiful print, richly inked, and it's included in this exhibition. Every time I see the high quality of a Tyler Graphic's print, it inspires me to keep pushing our own editions to be better. And then, a year later, I was fortunate enough to buy the original conte crayon drawing that was the source image for Ken Tyler's print. As a publisher, I love to see how another publisher has "interpreted" an existing original work of art into a print edition, especially someone as great as Ken Tyler and with one of our artists.

Many prints are created based on original works from the artist. Prints allow the artist to explore the same image in different ways by experimenting with size, color, textures, etc. And, if it's a homerun image, there can be many of them, not just one. Inspired, I wanted to now make our own print based on the same original work Ken Tyler used. Our print, Four Red Poppies, April 24, 2024 is larger and made using an inkjet printer, a newer technology at the time Ken Tyler closed his printshop. Our print visually captures all the details of Sultan's original work beautifully and looks so different from Ken Tyler's. And, we've even made a much smaller version with hand-torn edges to help benefit this exhibition. Thank you, Donald!

We've been working now with Donald Sultan for over 25 years. We were brought together by our co-founder. George Mulder, who was a publisher from Amsterdam. George spent a lot of time in New York City during the mid-80's working on print projects such as The Reigning Queens with Andy Warhol, Andy Mouse which was a collaboration with Andy Warhol and Keith Haring, and Silence=Death, The Apocalypse, and The Valley with Keith Haring: the latter two projects with Haring included text by William S. Burroughs, the beat poet and author of The Naked Lunch. Robert met George while organizing an exhibition for Keith Haring's work in St. Louis, shortly after Keith died in 1990. At the time, Robert was transitioning from his successful interior design career where he found himself more and more to be enjoying the buying and selling of high-end artwork to his sophisticated clientele. George opened up the world of fine art print publishing to Robert, and Lococo-Mulder. Inc. was formed in 1992. At the suggestion of Henry

Geldzahler, former curator of American and 20th Century Art at the Metropolitan Museum of Art, (and friend of George Mulder), our first project was born: *The Seven Deadly Sins* by William S. Burroughs. Robert had the idea to have Burroughs write original text about the seven deadly sins and the portfolio of (14) shotgun woodblock, silkscreen prints was printed by Durham Press in Pennsylvania, at George's suggestion. We split the text up to make (7) text prints, and Burroughs created (7) shotgun panels and hand-painted collage elements for the (7) image prints. At the time, Burroughs was enjoying great attention as a visual painter, shooting at balloons filled with paint attached to blocks of wood at a farm in Lawrence, Kansas. There's a video of this on our website (worth a look). The project was warmly received by museums and adventurous collectors.

Seven years later, and after George Mulder had moved back to Europe to work with Liu Ye, we published our first project with Donald Sultan called Five Objects which were small silkscreen prints with gold leaf that looked like etchings. These prints were printed by Alexander Heinrici in New York City. Alexander was the first printer for Andy Warhol, notably printing the Ladies and Gentleman and Mick Jagger prints in 1975. Alexander could figure out how to do just about anything with silkscreen, faithfully bringing the essence of the artist's original work into the print medium. With silkscreens, you could print on a variety of materials and add elements to the silkscreen inks while they were still wet, like flocking and sand. Flock or flocking is usually a synthetic material, like short fibers, that gives you a velvety texture when applied to the wet inks and allowed to dry. We published our first "poppy" prints with Sultan in 2007 and these were printed by Heinrici. Alexander used flocking and then once the flocking was dried, printed over the flocking to achieve the "tar-like" texture mimicking the actual tar and spackle that Donald uses on his paintings. And, Sultan's paintings are unlike any others, they are almost like stage sets that have been lifted up and affixed to the wall. Their surface texture and volume in a room are very satisfying to live with and a challenge to turn into prints!

From that first project which was a portfolio of (5) prints measuring 24 x 24 inches, we saw that we had a clear "favorite" image, *Three Reds, April 25, 2007* and have continued to explore that same image over the years with Donald in prints and sculptures in different sizes, colors, and variations. Now, Donald's son, Penn, is printing our silkscreen prints with Donald and we continue to innovate and explore print making, using sand to achieve the actual cement Donald is using in his new paintings. We are also exploring new ways to make sculpture editions, with bronze and cast concrete versions on the near horizon made by our fabricator, S.O.A.C., in St. Louis.

This is our 2nd exhibition here at American University Museum at the Katzen Arts

Center. We organized an exhibition of black and white prints by Alex Katz in 2016 (Black and White) with the help of the art dealer Alexander Meverovich in San Francisco. who is a close friend of the Museum's director, Jack Rasmussen. We are the primary print publisher for Alex Katz. When Jack asked me if we would be interested in having another exhibition at the museum, I eagerly agreed. I wanted to have an exhibition about publishing prints, to give some insight into how they come to be, and show what we have done with Donald Sultan. I wanted to do another version of the Four Red Flowers image that Ken Tyler used to make his print, so we did. We photographed the original work with the best digital camera available and added an additional lens. We were able to capture all the detail of the work and paper that it's on. We then edited the image, changed the colors, and printed the prints with an inkjet printer in (2) sizes: (4) very large and a much smaller "red" print edition (with hand-torn edges) to benefit this exhibition. Both the very large Four Red Poppies, April 24, 2024 and smaller Four Reds, July 4, 2025 are in this exhibition. You can see that the resolution and detail is amazing! The pigment based inks are as resilient if not more so than silkscreen inks now. Inkiet printing is another way to make beautiful prints, allowing for

endless editing options and can be very cost effective for publishers. By no means will it take the place of hands-on methods of printing

like etching, lithography, silkscreen, and woodcut, but will add to the ways that artists and printers and publishers can make prints.
























